Bring	- 1 set of your relevant documents and Portfolio for your own reference		
	- NRIC, documents listed in your SMS/Email notification		
	- Portfolio (Originals and at least 2 Sets of photocopied certificates)		
	- Digital Portfolio – ensure the device is fully charged and files are organised for showcasing seamlessly

interview	- Aptitude Tests (on site testing or candidate will receive an online link)		
formats	- Individual Interviews of 5-10 minutes. The interviewer may ask you to explain your		
	portfolio (e.g. Diploma of Architecture or DSA to AEP)		
	- Panel Interviews (a few interviewers to 1 student – formal)		
	- Group Interviews (1 interviewer to a few students – formal/informal)		
	- Answer first every once In a while. Do not dominate the conversation		
	- Show consideration towards fellow interviewees		
	- Case Interviews (candidates to perform tasks individually or in groups)		
	- They are observing your ability to work in a team under pressure, problem		
	solving, analytical, creativity and communication skills		
Make first	Statistics* has shown that interview success is determined by:		
impressions	- 55% The way you dress, act and walk through the door		
count	- 38% The quality of your voice, grammar and confidence		
	- 7% The words you choose to say		
	- Greet the interviewer		
	- Positive body language, e.g., eye contact, hands on lap, sit tall with legs together		
	- Be alert, enthusiastic and sincere		
	- Smile and Nod (It is a sign of respect and you are listening intently to them)		
	- Do not fidget unnecessarily and turn off your mobile phone

	Tips for Online Interview :		
	- Instead of looking at the person on the screen, look directly into the webcam		
	- Speak clearly and avoid rushing		
Engage the	- Get straight to the point and stay on the topic		
interviewers	- Ask for clarification where necessary		
through the	- Use specific examples (refer to your write-ups where possible) rather than general		
conversation	statements when giving information about your education, leadership roles, skills,		
	and/or passion		
	- Summarise, with enthusiasm, your interest in the course		
	- Thank the interviewer(s)

End on an	- Thank the interviewers politely and warmly	
impressive note	- Do not blog or post anything online pertaining to the interview
